

Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA)

The Tennessee Credit Union (TTCU) recognizes its responsibility to protect the privacy of our youngest members. We are committed to protecting our young members and other visitors as they visit our kids section of our website.

It is the intent of TTCU to comply with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) that governs and protects the privacy of our youngest members. For purposes of these guidelines, our youngest members are children under the age of 13. The online financial services offered through TTCU's website are not designated for or directed toward children under age 13. Parents of individuals within this age group may register for online accounts.

We do not knowingly solicit or collect data from children, and we do not knowingly market to children online without express parental consent or notification. If we receive online information from anyone that we know to be a child including personal information such as name, address, email, account number, telephone, and social security number, we will only use the information to respond directly to a child's request, seek parental consent, or provide parental notice. We will not sell, give, or share their personal information to/with any third party vendor or any other organization.

TTCU may collect information on domain names, dates and times of visits, and number of page views. This information contains no personal information. It will only be used to keep track of usage of our site and help improve our member's overall website experience. Visitor information is never sold, given, or discussed with third parties.
